**Ages:** Most age grades are age at 31st December 2020, e.g. for under 14, you must be 12 or 13 on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020. The only exception is for Masters Age grades, which are age on the day, with results recorded in 5-year age groups from 35 years plus.

**Course location / Description:** The course is run at the often used Waipuna Park on a good surface with undulating terrain. The course is suitable for spikes.

**Directions:** The Venue is Waipuna Park, Kaitemako Road, Welcome Bay, Tauranga, parking is available on site.

**Facilities:** The venue has toilets on site. There will be limited cover of club tents/gazebos.

Prize-giving: Presentations will be held at the venue at approximately 3.45pm.

**Eligibility:** To be eligible for an Athletics Waikato BOP championship placing, athletes (including masters' grades) must be registered as a competitive athlete with Athletics Waikato-Bay of Plenty. Social registered and non-registered (unaffiliated) athletes may compete but are ineligible for Athletics Waikato Bay of Plenty championship placing or medals. Child athletes are to note that you must have registered for the new season starting April 2020 to be eligible for the Championships, your previous summer membership from the 2019/20 season will have now expired.

Grades: Where races are combined, the grades will be separated in the results.

**Closing date:** Entries are to be made online by Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> July. Entries on the day will be available with an extra \$5 late entry fee per person

Athletics Waikato-Bay of Plenty team to the National Cross-Country Championships – Dunedin Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> August 2020. The Waikato Bay of Plenty Cross-Country team will be selected from those entered at close of entries for the championships. Athletes entering these championships must enter themselves via **www.athletics.org.nz** before the entry closing date. Note that an athlete subsidy of NZ Cross-Country Championships entry fee will be available for those selected to represent Waikato-Bay of Plenty. This is \$50 and may be received only by athletes who have entered the Waikato-Bay of Plenty Cross-Country Championships in 2020.

**Course maps:** A 2 km lap is used with a 1km lap only for the U14 Girls/Boys 3km and the non-championship U10 race:
