Please sign in before competing, use the contact tracing poster or sign in sheets displayed at the venue.

Competitors in event #2 should stay away until the participants of race #1 have left (approximately 11.30am).

There will be no prizegiving

There will be NO SPECTATORS allowed. If you are a parent, then please stay away from the start/finish area and the course. You should send your child to the start/finish area a few minutes before their race. Everyone is to leave immediately after their race.

Warm up is on the grass field next to the Sports Centre Car park. Please be mindful about not congregating in a group when warming up.

Grade is age as at 31st December 2020, except for master grades where it is age on day of the race

IMPORTANT NOTE: The registration season runs from 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021. If you joined a club during the summer, you will need to re-register for the 2020-21 season after 1st April 2020 to be eligible for a Championship placing and to receive a medal. Please contact your club to arrange.

Course location / Description: The event is being held at St. Peter's School, Cambridge. Please enter the grounds through the main gates and park at the Robb Sports Centre – take the first right after going through the school gates. The start/finish area is a short walk from the car park. Please keep away from the start/finish area until a few minutes before your race.

The main course is a 2.5 km out and back loop over mainly flat terrain giving race distances of either 2.5km, 5km, 7.5km or 10km, except for the Under 16 race which will be 4km. For the under 16 race, athletes will turn early on the second lap, running a 2.5km lap first, followed by a 1.5km lap.

The 2.5 km course map is below:



Facilities: Toilets will be close to start/finish area. Club tents can be placed in the field next to the start area prior to 11am. Parking is in the Robb Sports Centre Car Park – take the first right after entering the school grounds through the main gates.

Prize-giving / Refreshments: There will be no Prizegiving this year

Eligibility:

To be eligible for an Athletics Waikato BOP championship placing, athletes (including masters' grades) must be registered as a competitive athlete with Athletics Waikato-Bay of Plenty. Non-registered (unaffiliated) or socially registered athletes may compete but are **ineligible** for Athletics Waikato Bay of Plenty championship placing or medals. Note that the current registration season is from 1st April 2020 to 31st March 2021.

Grades: Where races are combined, the grades will be separated in the results.

Ages: Masters graded athletes is age on the day, with results recorded in 5-year age groups. All other grades age is at 31 December 2020.

Closing date: Entries must be made online by **Thursday 20th August 2020**. **NO ON THE DAY ENTRIES**

Athletics Waikato-Bay of Plenty team to the New Zealand Road Championships (Sunday 7th November 2020), Auckland. The Waikato BOP team will be selected from those entered at **close** of entries for the championships **ENTRIES: ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE ONLINE BY THE ATHLETES THEMSELVES**
