A big welcome to all the athletes that "Had a Go" on the days we put on. We would love to see you all at our future meetings.



# Pan Pac Games Brisbane 8-10 November 2024

I've always wanted to compete at a Pan Pac Games. The attraction of all the festivities and the fact that the Games usually attracts competitors that don't compete at Masters athletics events was also exciting.

How easy, just book your flights, accommodation and enter. This is what I did in 2019 and finally five years later I get to attend. Covid event cancellations were to blame for the first four years and then we found out that this year it was due to track maintenance at the Gold Coast, so the Masters athletics events took place in Brisbane. So, I've kind of attended a Pan Pac Games. Nevertheless, it was a well run meeting with great competitors and friendly officials. In the M60 it attracted over ten competitors in 60m, 100m, Discus and Shot Put. Trevor Watson had a great competition achieving three out of three gold medals for his events and achieving a new WBOP record for the 100m.

All the New Zealand competitors I spoke to were feeling the heat. Phew, over 30 degrees every day with a small breeze to cool us down.
